BENEVOLENCE

The Association receives requests for financial assistance from the serving and retired community each year. These financial awards are assessed upon need, and can include help towards household items, disability living aids, removal expenses and personal items such as hearing aids or glasses.

WHO CAN APPLY FOR BENEVOLENCE

- Anyone who has served as a Regular or Reserve member of the QARANC, or its predecessor organisations, with one day's paid service or more
- You are in need or distress or need financial assistance to help you achieve a reasonable quality of life
- You do not need to have been a member of the Association to apply

GRANTS

All Association members are eligible to apply for a grant. The Committee will consider applications for:

- Help towards the provision of social gatherings to promote comradeship, fostering esprit de Corps
- Branch activities
- Commemorative and other events that preserve Corps traditions
- Support to serving members on operations
- Grants for adventurous training and sporting activities
